Conditions of Entry

The APAHO Assoc. Inc. Horse of the year 'Show horses on the Swan' event is to be run Under the Australasia Pacific Arabian Horse Organisation rules of entry. Ignorance of the Rules will not be accepted as an excuse for any breach. The appointment of a Steward or Marshal does not absolve the competitor from complying with the rules.

Membership & Horse Registration

- All riders and handlers must be current members of APAHO to be exempt from Paying the day participation fee. The fee is per person, per day. Any person entering The show ring without paying this fee and signing a liability waiver will be disqualified.
- This event is open to Show Horses and Show Hunters of any breed, including unregistered horses and tractable stallions.
- Horses in classes 9-12 & 15-20 must be registered with the Arabian Horse Society of Australia and be owned or leased by a current member of APAHO. Arabian Performance Index recorded horses are not eligible for these classes.

Age of Riders/Handlers & Horses

- Rider age is at 1 Jan 21
- Leading Rein Riders must be 5yrs old and over on the day of competition.
- Leading Rein Handlers must be 18yrs and over on the day of competition.
- Horse/Pony must be 3 years of age and over at 1 Aug 21

Eligibility

- All that have previously competed in a HOTY event within the current year are still eligible to compete at an APAHO HOTY event.
- Show Horse/Hunter - If a Horse/Pony is entered as a Show Hunter at any other HOTY event, it will be precluded from entering the APAHO HOTY event as a Show Horse and vice versa.
- All horses in Show Horse, Show Hunter and Leading Rein classes must have a Current height certificate that can be produced on the day (copies and photos not accepted)

Entries

- A current valid email address must be provided with entry
- The horse is entered under its full registered name
- Riders must be declared at time of entry
- Any changes must be put in writing and submitted to the organising committee no less than 72 hours prior to competition.
- If there are any errors or if you do not receive confirmation of your entry, please Contact NOMINATE immediately.
- The onus is on the competitor to ensure they have entered correctly
- The committee and its directors reserve the right to accept or reject any entry.

Close of Entries

- Entries close at Midnight on the 3rd September 2021
- Entries after closing date will attract a \$60 late fee per horse and will only be accepted if submitted by Midnight on the 8th September 2021.

Refund Policy

- Entry fees will not be refunded without a vet certificate. Certificates must be received By the organising committee at least 72 hours prior to the event and any refunds will be at the discretion of the organisers.

Swabbing

- APAHO Assoc. Inc. and its organising committee reserve the right to swab any exhibit competing at their events.

Show Day Office

- Will be open on the grounds to collect your show packs only between the hours of 6:30am - 7:45am on the 18th September 2021.

Arena Familiarization

- Will be between the times of 6:30am - 7am. All horses entering the ring for familiarization must remain at a WALK . Competitors are welcome to warm up and/or lunge horses at trot and canter on the lawn area available at the venue.

Workouts

- All Show Horse, Show Hunter & Leading Rein will have a set workout that will be included in the show catalogue and not available before.

Marshalling

- Horses will compete in catalogue order
- Exhibitors should have their horses in the marshalling area no later than 10 minutes prior to start of class.
- No refunds will be given for those that miss their classes.
- The Marshal will call you a maximum of 2 times only, before moving on to the next competitor. If you need extra time (ie: gear change) you must notify the Marshal before he calls your number to the ring.
- Only the Horse, Rider and/or Handler are to be present in the Marshalling area. No spectators or family members are to be standing or walking through the marshalling area. This is for SAFETY reasons and it will be monitored.

Float Parking

- Only competitor floats and cars are to be parked on the grass reserve area
- All spectators and general admission must park their vehicles in the bitumen public Car park provided at the reserve.
- Cars parked in our emergency vehicle access zones will be towed.

Swan River

- No horses are to enter the Swan River
- No dogs allowed on the grounds
- Horse drinking water is available from the tap near the toilet block
- All waste water must be clean from detergents if tipping excess out on to surrounding gardens.
- No waste water of any kind is to be tipped in to the Swan River

Tie up & Yards

- We have STALLIONS at this event. Do not leave your horses unattended.
- The organising committee takes no responsibility for horses breaking loose from floats and/or float yards. Tie them, Yard them and Supervise them at all times.

Stallion Owners

- Stallions are to have a handler/trainer with them at all times.
- Stallions seen to be striking, breaking loose or aggressive will be asked to leave the grounds immediately for the safety of others.
- Stallions are to wear a coloured exhibit number

Timetable

- Will be released 7 days after close of entries and not before. A link will be posted to the timetable on the event Facebook page.

Show Fees

- Compulsory Admin \$45 per entry (includes exhibit numbers & A4 coloured catalogue)
- Participation Insurance \$15 per person / per day (for all Non APAHO members)
- All Ridden Classes \$45 each (APAHO members)
- All Ridden Classes \$55 each (Non-members)
- All Led Classes \$30 (APAHO members)
- All Led Classes \$40 (Non-members)
- Late Entry Fee \$60 per entry
- Compulsory Grounds Fee \$10 per horse / per day

Placing's

- Champion Exhibit, Reserve Champion Exhibit
- Up to Top 5 Finalist if entry numbers permit
- Awards will be given out at the discretion of the organisers and may consist of one or multiple of the following;
sashes, rosettes, garlands, jewellery, rugs, glassware and/or sponsored prizes,
cash or products rendered

Prizes & Presentation

- All prizes must be collected on the day, or they will be forfeited.
- Participation of presentations on the day is compulsory.

Licensed Marquee & Ticketed Seating

- You must be aged 18yrs+ to buy a ticket to the Marquee or Ringside Seats. Service will only be given to those with a valid ticket and on proof of age. The service of alcohol will be at the discretion of the organiser. Alcohol is not for sale at this event, it is included only with the purchase of a table ticket and is limited to the organisers license.

General Public Admission

- This event is free to the general public. Free admission spectators will not have access to the ticketed seating areas or the marquee.

Indemnity

Competitors indemnify APAHO Assoc. Inc, the Organising Committee and The City of Victoria Park against all claims, losses, suits and damages made against or suffered by the Committee by reason of any negligent act or omission on the part of any riders, trainers or attendants whilst they are attending, riding or otherwise handling a horse, and agree that any act or omission on the part of such riders or attendants found in any action against the Committee to be negligent, shall be deemed to have been negligent for the purpose of any claim under this indemnity. Riders are required to sign the declaration form included in the entry section. Neither APAHO Assoc. Inc, nor the Organising Committee or their appointed officials accept any liability for any accident, theft or illness to horses, riders, grooms or any person or property whatsoever.
