SHOW RULES:

- ✓ AHSA Rules apply unless otherwise specified.
- ✓ Horses to be formally presented in rings 1-3, riders to wear a collared polo-shirt, show shirt, rat-catcher shirt or similar.
- ✓ All exhibits to be registered with the A.H.S.A, with the exception of those competing in the 'Come and Try' Ring 4. Ring 4 is open to all breeds.
AHSA breed registration papers and current AHSA membership cards are to be presented on the day when nominating.
- ✓ All competitors and handlers must be a member of either the Arabian Horse Society of Australia or the Arabian Valley Horse Club.
Competitors and handlers who are members of EA or SHC can complete a liability waiver and show proof of current membership and be eligible to compete.
All other competitors must apply for day membership and pay a \$10.00 day membership fee.
- ✓ Coloured wristbands will be allocated at nominations. All handlers and riders must wear a wristband when competing, handling or riding a horse throughout the event.
- ✓ Arabian Performance Index (API) registered horses are to compete in Ring 3 and are not eligible for the Arabian Derivative classes in Ring 2.
- ✓ Competitors in the 'come and try' ring 4 may compete in rings 1-3, however all exhibits in rings 1-3 must be registered with the AHSA.
- ✓ Rings should not be held to wait for competitors in other classes, except at the judge's discretion.
- ✓ Horses in the endurance horse classes in Ring 4 must hold a yellow logbook with the Australian Endurance Horse Riders Association (AERA).
- ✓ **Horses should not compete in both open hack and open hunter classes. It is the responsibility of the competitor to choose the appropriate class, and eligibility of horses in hunter classes will be decided at the judge's discretion.**
A Show Hunter should possess more substance than the modern ridden Show horse, but it must be emphasised they should be quality animals. A quality Show Hunter must create the impression that it is capable of hunting over a variety of terrain and must be sound and well-conformed to do this comfortably and safely for his rider. Show hunters must be ridden in plain browbands.
- ✓ Competitors enter the show venue and compete at their own risk. All non-competitors (including spectators, helpers, volunteers, vendors etc) enter the venue at their own risk.

- ✓ Helmets meeting current safety standards are to be worn at all time while mounted and riding at the venue.
- ✓ All protests must be made within 30 minutes of the alleged breach of rule. They must be in writing and accompanied by \$50. If the protest is dismissed, the money will not be refunded.
- ✓ The Committee of the AVHC reserves the right to alter the program as deemed necessary
- ✓ At the Judge's discretion:
 - Classes may be combined (where there are less than three competitors) or split (where there are too many competitors for safety)
 - Competitors will be allowed a reasonable amount of time at the judge's discretion to complete gear changes when seeking to compete over all eligible versatility classes.
- ✓ A pony is not exceeding 14hh, a Galloway is over 14hh and not exceeding 15hh, and a Hack is over 15hh
- ✓ Pleasure classes are to be ridden in a snaffle bit (no curb chain, drop noseband, or artificial aides)
- ✓ All colts/stallions are to be handled in either a halter chain or bitted and must handled by a person 18 years and over.
- ✓ Novice classes are:
 - for horses or riders that have not won an open championship at a similar show (including agricultural shows).
 - to be ridden in a snaffle bit
- ✓ **Special ring 4 regulations:**
 - Cantering is not compulsory in Ring 4 classes.
 - Formal show clothing and horse show tack are not compulsory, but riders and horses should be neat and tidy with safe equestrian attire paramount. (boots with heels, helmets, and well-fitting saddlery correctly used).
 - Competitors in ring 4 are encouraged to use any style of tack they are most comfortable with, providing that tack is safe and serviceable for both horse and rider. No penalties will be applied to competitors who wish to use non-english tack as all tack is acceptable for all classes in ring 4, including stock saddles, endurance saddles, western saddles ect.
- ✓ No dogs permitted.
- ✓ All Rings will break at 12:30 noon for lunch with rings resuming at 1pm.

HIGH POINT VERSATILITY AWARDS, RING 1-4: To be awarded at the completion of each ring. The high point versatility winner from each ring is judged from a one horse/rider combination.

Entry fee: \$10.00, (plus AVHC Inc. membership if applicable)

- A.** Each ring will have a high point versatility Youth and High Point Versatility Adult rider. High point youth will be calculated from results in youth only classes.
- B.** Entrants may only compete for the high point versatility award in ONE ring.
- C.** With the exception of trail classes, barrel race and harness, only classes within each individual ring are counted towards that ring's high point versatility award.
- D.** Entrants must Compete in a halter class, and a **minimum** of three under-saddle classes. Entrants may compete in as many saddle classes as they wish, with each class result accumulating points. Only one halter class result will be counted, however all eligible point-scoring under saddle classes will be counted.
- E.** Trail class, barrel race and harness class events in ring four are eligible point-scoring classes for the point scores of all other rings.
- F.** Maiden and novice classes in both hunter and hack divisions are **not eligible point-scoring classes**.
- G.** To be eligible for the overall versatility award in any ring, riders must be a current financial member of the AVHC Inc. Membership forms will be available on the day.
- H.** Points are awarded for places 1st-4th, with 1 point allocated for placings below fourth. The combination with the highest overall point score is judged the winner.
- I.** Upon nomination, riders will receive a number which is to be worn during all classes so as stewards can record results and allocate points.
- J.** In the event of a tie, the committee reserves the right to set an additional workout to determine a tie-breaker.
