- 1. The organizers/committee of Log Fence Pony Club (LFPC) reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any events they seem necessary on the day.
- 2. All riders must always wear a current approved helmet and riding boots when mounted.
- All riders entering this event must be a 2020 financial riding member of PCAWA and proof of membership must be produced on day of event. NO PROOF OF MEMBERSHIP = NO RIDE.
- 4. Riding attire can be either pony club full uniform, hacking attire or fancy dress. In hand class attire must be appropriate and enclosed footwear must be worn.
- 5. Plaiting is optional.
- 6. All leading rein handlers must wear enclosed footwear. Ponies must be led by a single lead attached to the nose band, no halters or leads with chains to be used.
- 7. Rider's age will be as on the day of the event.
- 8. The LFPC and its committee, judges and officials do not accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness, injury to horses/ponies, owners/riders, or any spectators or property whatsoever. Entry to the grounds is at your own risk and by entering this event you agree to take all liability for anything that may occur.
- 9. No judge is to be approached at any time by a competitor or spectator without speaking to a LFPC committee member first.
- 10. The decision of the judge is final. Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated.
- 11. Strictly NO double bridles.
- 12. NO DOGS allowed on the grounds.
- 13. All competitors are ultimately responsible for knowing the PCAWA competitor rules and complying with them. PCAWA gear checking rules apply, no gear check = no start.
- 14. LFPC has several day yards available for use. They are first come first serve. It is requested that chains be hung back up before leaving the grounds.
- 15. Manure can be scattered across the grounds. Please DO NOT leave manure around trees as this will kill them.

The canteen will be open all day of the competition for purchase of hot and cold food, and drinks. Please try to pre order your lunch in the morning to give our wonderful canteen ladies the opportunity to have your lunch ready to go.

Rings will start with in hand classes, on completion of the in hand there will be a 30-minute morning tea break and ridden classes will commence shortly afterwards.
