 - Current, valid HRCAV membership and dressage performance card must be presented to the Event Secretary prior to competing in HRCAV classes
- Riders may only compete in a maximum of 3 EA tests per day
- If a rider is eligible to compete in BOTH HRCAV and EA tests, then they may only compete in a total of 4 tests in any one day, irrelevant of the test affiliation eg: 2 EA tests and 2 HRCAV tests = 4 tests total. This is the maximum.
- HRCAV registered club colours must be worn in HRCAV tests
- HRCAV riders must supply their own numbers for both sides of the horse
- HRCAV rules and regulations apply to HRCAV tests and HRCAV riders
- HRCAV riders may compete at their assessed Level and the next higher Level
- HRCAV prizes as per Event Rule 25
- EA rules and regulations apply to all other tests and riders
- Anyone who pays a Lucindale PA&H Society membership is eligible to enter the Closed Restricted classes
- Stock Horse Tests are judged under EA Rules with the exception of saddle, nose bands and dress. Current EA hard hat rules apply.
