EQUESTRIAN CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Please note all entries close 7th Oct. 2019 Late entries will be accepted and will incur a late fee.

Horse conditions of entry to be read in conjunction with the General Rules and those for show jumping.

- All events will be conducted in accordance with current EA Saddle Horse Judges and Competitors Rules.
- All horses must be measured or owners must provide a current height certificate. Proof of measurement must be available for inspection upon request.
- 3. All Stallions or Colts must be led by an adult over 18 years and bitted. Stallions permitted in stallion classes only unless otherwise stated. All Stallions or Colts 1 year and over to be shown in a bridle with a bit. Irrespective of breed regulations. No exceptions.
- The committee reserves the 22. right to alter, add or delete from the program as the circum- 23. stances dictate.
- Only financial members of the Breed Societies are eligible to show in their respective Classes.
- 6. The Judges decision is final.
- 7. Dress: All competitors must be correctly and suitably attired whilst competing in any arena, this also applies to the schooling/exercising of horses at any time. EA ruling on helmets applies. AS/NZS 3838, ARB HS 2012, ASTN F1163, SNELL E2001, PAS015, VG1. Riders under 18 years are not permitted to wear gaiters/chapettes in riding competitions or smartest on parades
- Age of Riders. Birth Certificates may need to be provided for riders 18 years and under if requested. Age is on the day of the show. Refer to Show Jumping Section for age requirements.
- 10. District horse/rider must reside within 100km of post office. Intermediate: not to have won first prize at a Royal Newcomer Open classes are for horses that have not been competed in any discipline under saddle prior to 1.1.17.The EV newcomer season is 12months from the 1st of Jan each year.
- 11. Any competitor that wins a hacking Championship in one ring is ineligible to compete in an open hacking class in another ring on the same day.
- Random swabbing may occur as per EA/VAS ruling
- 13. **Competitors** must choose to show Open or Hunter
- 14. Limited brick stables are available Stable hire \$10 a day to be booked and paid for with entries. Preference will be given to stallions, distance, other.
- Stables to be cleaned on exit or a cleaning fee can be paid to stabling steward.
- A number of concrete approx.
 3mx2m stalls are available,

- these stalls require you to supply your own gate or ropes across the front. These are in asphalt lanes.
- Building of personal yards is permitted but limited space is available for this.
- 18. Please notify the stabling steward of any concerns regarding stabling at time of placing entries and the requirement of building yards.
- 19. Stables MUST be vacated by 3pm on last day of your competition to allow other competitors to enter the stables.
- 20. **Protests** must be lodged in writing with the show secretary within 30 minutes of the event being judged. A deposit of \$100 will be returned if the protest is upheld. If the protest is denied the fee will be forfeited
- 21. Refunds before close of entries attract \$10 administration fee, no refunds after close of entries unless a doctor or vets certificate is produced within 7 days.
- 22. **Late entries** will be accepted but will incur a late fee.
- In the event of equal placings, prizes and/or prize money to split.
