## **Mt Barker Annual Horse Show Rules**

#### • Do Not Ride On The Race Track

- Approved Safety helmets and riding boots to be worn whilst mounted—including Fancy Dress and ASH classes
- Age as at day of show
- Hay is permitted, but please pick up all excess on the ground. Fill in any holes if your horse has damaged the ground
- All manure/hay to be placed in designated areas. Please clean up your area and place rubbish in bins provided
- Use designated warm up areas to work your horse.
- Horses must be lunged in the enclosed arena by the stockyards- there is to be no lunging on the arenas or warm up areas.
- District Hack—The horse/pony and rider must reside within the Plantagenet or Cranbrook Shires.
- Pony Club uniform may be worn in the Encourage rings, novelties and Junior Show Jumping only.
- A Ground Fee of \$10 is payable for each horse/pony entered.
- \$2 Ambulance fee per rider an ambulance will be on the ground all day for your safety.
- The Disclaimer must be read, understood and accepted on Nominate
- ALL entries are to be done online at <a href="www.nominate.com.au">www.nominate.com.au</a>. NO postal entries accepted.
- Instruction on how to use Nominate will be posted on the Mt Barker Horse Show Facebook Page
- One Nominate Entry per rider, if required multiple horses can be entered under the one rider.
- Entries close Monday 28<sup>th</sup> October 10pm
- \$20 per horse helper fee if you supply a helper for each horse this fee will be reimbursed by Nominate within 1 week of the show. If you don't want to supply a helper you won't be reimbursed. If you want to supply a helper in order to have the \$20 reimbursed you need to include the following details when prompted to do so in Nominate: Helper Name, Helper Phone Number and Helper Email.
- Helper duties will be roughly 1 hour.
- Limited Self-Help positions available. You must email <a href="mailto:kimadams2@hotmail.com">kimadams2@hotmail.com</a> in order to get a self-help position and it will be first in first served. A rider can only do a max of 1 self-help duty.
- Helper Duties will be emailed out on Friday the 1<sup>st</sup> of November.
