



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- All Pintos must be fit & well for at least the week prior to the event & must not be brought to the event if they are unwell. Any expenses caused by any biosecurity breach which causes a shutdown of the event will be the responsibility of the person in charge of the pintos at the event. Q.P.H.A. Inc. will not be responsible for any costs involved in a shutdown.
- Horse health declarations must be handed in for ALL horses/ponies, whether they are competing or not. Horse Health Declarations must be handed to a committee member before your stables will be unlocked if you are stabling, otherwise they must be handed in to receive your competitors pack which contains your back number. Arrival & Departure times of all horses/ponies must be noted on our record sheet at the office. Please stop on your arrival and departure and write your time and sign beside your horses name at the office.
- Hendra Vaccination is not compulsory to compete. If vaccinated please include copy of current certificate with entries. We will have vets able to be called to the grounds in an emergency but it is the vets decision if they treat a non-Hendra vaccinated horse/pony.
- PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU READ ALL YOUR FORMS AND THAT THEY ARE FILLED OUT CORRECTLY WITH ALL INFORMATION. Entries will only be accepted if completed on our nomination forms, not in any other way.
- Entries close 6pm 31/8/18. Last mail to be received by the 31st or charged late entry fee. Late entries will be accepted after closing date at the late entry fee on the competition days only (at the office only!). No correspondence regarding entries will be available via any committee member between the 31/8/18 and the 20/9/18 inclusive. We will acknowledge receipt of entries and that all is correct when we receive them. If you do not get an acknowledgment, but have sent your entries in, please contact us by 6pm on the 31st August 2018 to follow this up.
- > No Late Entries for Dressage or Futurities these must be pre-nominated by 31/8/18
- We have limited cash in the office, please bring small notes and coins if possible for late entries and raffle tickets.
- Stable refund is only available if your stable is signed off clean by inspection with a committee member before you leave. Also please ensure your bank details are included on the nomination form if you are stabling as all refunds will be paid by direct deposit back into your account.
- Back number refunds will be given to you once you finish competing when you return your back number to the office.
- Dressage will be run to draw time and competitors must adhere to these times and be ready for Gear Check 10 minutes prior your allocated draw time. Dressage Scratchings – a competitor can ride earlier into a scratching draw time but can't ride in a later scratching than their draw time.
- If dogs are on the grounds at any stage they MUST be on a lead at all times or in a crate/cage. They are not allowed near the horse areas at all, unless they are assistance/guide dogs and approved by QPHA Inc committee
- PLEASE ENSURE BEFORE YOU SEND IN NOMINATION FORMS YOU HAVE READ THE QPHA INC DEFINITIONS AND JUDGING GUIDELINES (DOWNLOAD FROM OUR WEBSITE).



RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. The QPHA Inc. Show Committee reserves the right to alter the program if necessary. Classes may be combined or judged at the same time if there are insufficient entries in any classes.
- 2. All exhibits MUST be adult registered or foal recorded with a recognised incorporated pinto association in Australia. Photocopy of registration papers MUST be provided if NOT registered with the QPHA Inc.
- 3. All owners of exhibits entered to compete MUST be financial members with their respective pinto association. Photocopy of membership MUST be provided if NOT a QPHA Inc. member.
- 4. The QPHA Inc. assumes no responsibility for injury or damage to livestock, person or property of any owner, competitor or assistant. Each participant by the act of their entry waive all claim on the QPHA Inc. and its members.
- 5. Any person that harasses a Judge or Steward shall be deemed guilty of unseemly conduct and may be disqualified for the remainder of the show with all awards forfeited.
- 6. The QPHA Inc. Show Committee reserves the right to measure any pinto competing in classes with height stipulations.
- 7. Protests must be made in writing, accompanied by \$50.00 cash and be in the hands of a member of the show committee no later than 15 minutes after the completion of the class concerned. Should the grounds for protest be considered frivolous, this money will be forfeited.
- 8. All competitors in ridden sporting events must wear an approved safety helmet.
- 9. All persons in the ring must wear appropriate footwear and headgear. All handlers and riders aged 17 years and under must wear an approved safety helmet at all times when leading pintos and mounted (including western).
- 10. All pintos entered that are not registered with QPHA Inc. MUST comply with QPHA Inc. Colour and Breed requirements.
- 11. Animal welfare rules apply to this event as per EA/HSAA regulations. Any handler that mistreats his/her pinto may be disqualified for the remainder of the show with all awards forfeited.
- 12. If behaviour of a pinto is deemed to be dangerous a judge/steward or QPHA Inc committee member will ask the handler/rider to leave the ring with that pinto and QPHA Inc committee will assess if safe to continue in anymore classes at the show or not.
- 13. Insurance regulations require that ALL exhibitors and riders who are NOT members with the QPHA Inc, must pay day insurance of \$20 and sign a disclaimer to be able to compete. Please provide proof of membership.
- 14. There will be NO deviation from the rules including dress attire and equipment for pintos.
- 15. Lead Line & Walk & Trot classes Riders that compete in lead line classes cannot compete in walk & trot classes. Riders that compete in lead line or walk & trot cannot compete in any other ridden classes except classes that specify lead line or walk & trot, Smartest on Parade, Fancy Dress and the Walk/trot dressage test for walk & trot riders. They can be ridden in either English, Western or Australian Stock Horse attire but not a combination of both. If competing in other ridden classes during the show you cannot compete in the Lead Line/Assisted/Walk Trot classes.
- 16. Age of Pinto Regardless of when your pinto is born the age shall be calculated on the basis of a year commencing of the 1st day of August of the breeding season that it is foaled.
- 17. Pinto Age for Saddle Classes Pintos entered in saddle classes must be 3 years old or older. 3 year olds only allowed to enter a maximum of 4 ridden classes.
- 18. Stallion/Colt any height Are allowed to be shown in halter/led classes and all ridden classes where applicable by an Adult 18 years and over only. Stallion must be under the control of a competent handler/rider at all times. No stallion/colt in youth classes.
- 19. Youth Age 17 years and under at date of show
- 20. Amateur Owner An amateur is any person who is no longer eligible to show in youth classes (18 years and over) and has not been a professional in the horse industry for the last three years. Competitors wishing to enter Amateur classes MUST produce a current Membership Card with Amateur Owner listed on it.
- 21. Veteran classes These are for Pintos 16 years and over, you can only enter the one age/height class, so cannot enter a height class eg Mare 14hh-15hh and then also enter the Veteran mare class exc 14hh. The winner of the Veteran classes are eligible to compete for Champion of their section eg. Champion Pinto Mare exc 14hh.



CL1. Double Registered Pinto (not including any other pinto assoc; copy of registration papers from breed society to be included with entries. e.g. Paint, Part Arab, ASH etc)

CL2. Owners Group of Two Pintos (Pintos need not be related, but must be owned by one owner and registered as a pinto)

CL3. Sire's or Dam's progeny (minimum of 2 progeny and maximum 3 progeny by the SAME SIRE or SAME DAM to be shown in this class. Sire or Dam need not be Pinto, but resulting progeny being shown in this class MUST be registered pintos).

CL4. Sire or Dam & Progeny (Sire or Dam and a minimum of 1 progeny and a maximum of 2 progeny to be shown in this class. All horses must be registered Pintos).

Open Performance Classes

English, Western & Australian Stockhorse Attire (abbreviated after classes E, W or S) depending on attire required. Open Performance Western Classes will be judged as a western event whether the rider/horse is in Western or Australian Stockhorse attire.

Lead Line/assisted riders are not eligible to compete in any other ridden event except other lead line classes, fancy dress and smartest on parade). (E, W, S)

Walk & Trot Off Lead riders are not eligible to compete in any other ridden event, except walk/trot classes, fancy dress, smartest on parade and walk/trot dressage test). (*E*,*W*,*S*)

YOU CANNOT COMPETE IN LEAD LINE/WALK TROT CLASSES IF YOU COMPETE IN ANY OTHER TYPE OF RIDDEN CLASSES AT THE SHOW




