This Event will be held under current Equestrian Australia/FEI Horse Trial Rules,(and the National Eventing Rules January 2020 and all subsequent corrections and modifications as published by the FEI and EA with their provisions taking precedence

PLEASE NOTE : *Compliant Back Protectors will be compulsory for the x-country phase for all riders. See art EA 538.3.1 Cross-Country Body Protector and for compliant tagged helmets see Annex N of the rules*

EA 507. 6 Disclaimer of liability

Neither the Organising Committee of any event to which these rules apply nor Equestrian Australia accepts any liability for any accident, damage, injury, or illness to horses, riders, ground, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

EA 507.7 Reservation of right

The organiser reserves the right:

- To cancel any class or event
- To divide any class
- To transfer competitors between sections of a class
- To alter the advertised times
- To refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason

DRUGS AND SWABBING

The Ground Jury may at any time order the testing of any horse in accordance with the articles of the FEI Veterinary Regulations. It is a national requirement that at least 2 horses are swabbed at state championships.

Qualifications and eligibility

Riders please note that all qualifications listed as per Equestrian Australia rule book, must be fulfilled by the close of entries date.

Inter-School riders must be familiar with the specific qualification requirements.

Riders and owners of all horses competing in EvA 95 and above must be current members of EA. Horses must be EA registered and hold a current eventing license. For EvA 80, riders must be at least a Participation member of EA. EvA 65 and EvA 50 riders must be either a TEA or EA member.

CCN1*-S (INCLUDING INTERSCHOOL 1*)

Open to any EA member who from the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider reaches 13yrs and over, riding a registered horse turning 5years or over from the beginning of the calendar year. Both horse and rider must be qualified to compete in 1*

EvA95 (INCLUDING INTERSCHOOL EvA95)

Open to any EA member who from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 10yrs and over, riding a registered horse turning 5 years or over from the beginning of the calendar year. Riders under the age of 13 must have completed an EvA80.

EvA80 (INCLUDING INTERSCHOOL EvA80)

Open to any EA participation or full member who from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 8yrs and over , riding a horse turning 5 years or over from the beginning of the calendar year.

EvA65 and EvA50 (INCLUDING INTERSCHOOL EvA65)

To ride in EvA65 and EvA50, riders must be either TEA members (NTEC, STEA or NWEA) or EA members of at least Participation level. Note TEA membership only provides third party insurance and not the comprehensive cover of EA Membership.

INTERSCHOOL CHAMPIONSHIP -Equestrian Australia (Tasmanian Branch)

All interschool riders and horses need to be EA registered and hold a current Interschool card.

School riders may also enter their relevant EA eventing class by paying for each class but will only pay levies once.

INTERSCHOOL ODE CLASSES

Open to all riders who are current members of Equestrian Australia (or TEA clubs for Ev65). (Note TEA membership only provides third party insurance and not the comprehensive cover of EA Membership).

Please refer to membership and registration requirements above for each grade. The ODE classes are open to riders from 8 years of age. See age requirements above for grades.

INTERSCHOOL COMBINED TRAINING

The Combined Training competition is a dressage test and showjumping round. There is no cross country phase. Riders can enter both the ODE and CT at this event but can only compete nationally in one section. (Riders scores from the ODE section will be used for the CT section - i.e only ride once)

Open to Primary School riders enrolled up to and including year/grade 6 in the year of competition; or Secondary school riders enrolled from year 7 - 12.

NB: The Organising Committee reserves the right to alter any of the classes below according to entries received and to modify the conditions stated as is deemed necessary

The organising committee may reject an entry if it considers the Welfare of the horse may be at risk.

DRESS

As per Equestrian Australia rule no 538
School classes – formal school uniform.

PRIZES

EA Eventing classes:

Prizes in Equestrian Australia ODE classes will be awarded in accordance with current Equestrian Australia Rules for Official Horse Trials.

Prize money is dependent upon the number of starters and will be announced in the Official Program according to entries received..

Prize Money will be awarded in all EA classes to
3rd place

4th place if 10 or more starters

5th place if 15 or more starters

6th place if 20 or more starters

Ribbons will be presented in all classes

Interschool classes:

Interschool placegetters receive sashes to 4th.

REFUNDS

Refunds will be made according to the Rule Book with appropriate Medical/Veterinary Certificates, less administration fee.

ACCOMMODATION

Camping will be available at Quercus Park.

AGISTMENT – Yards are available at Quercus, however they must be booked via Nominate and a \$20 bond applies for use of yards. Upon inspection of the yard with manure and hay removed, the bond will then be refunded on the day. Horses staying in the yards overnight are to be supervised by the rider/owners.

CANTEEN

There will be a Canteen during the event.

WATER & WASHDOWN FACILITIES

Water will be limited. Please bring your own.

All riders must either attend a working bee or provide a non riding helper on the day
