Show Rules

1. AQHA, PHAA and Bundaberg & District WPC Inc. rules apply:
2. The Judge's decision is final. Events will be run under the rules of the AQHA, PHAA and the by-Laws of the Bundaberg and District Western Performance Club Inc.
3. For all Registered Horses - A copy of your Association membership/Amateur cards and horse registration papers must be sent with nominations.
4. LIABILITY: Bundaberg WPC Inc. will take no responsibility for any loss, damage or theft to any persons/horses, vehicles or property while at these shows. All competitors compete at their own risk.
5. Youth classes 18 years of age and under and must have parent/guardian signed consent.
6. BEGINNER: Is a Rider who has won no more than 3 wins with 5 or more horses. No Open Classes can be entered. Horses can be ridden in a snaffle bit or a curb bit (two handed). Beginners may not compete in open or novice classes.
7. BEGINNER Youth must wear an approved helmet with harness strap and are not permitted to compete on 2 or 3 year old horses.
8. Stallions may not compete in Beginner or youth Classes.
9. 2 Year Old horses may only enter a maximum of 3 ridden classes.
10. Novice Youth and Novice Amateur Classes: Must hold AQHA or other breed society Novice Amateur or Youth Card. Cannot enter Open Amateur or Open Youth classes. EG if a youth competes in a Novice Western Pleasure Class, they may not compete in the Open Youth Western Pleasure.
11. Ranch Riding horses are not permitted to compete in any Western Pleasure classes including Youth, Amateur and Beginner classes.
12. Western Pleasure horses are not permitted to compete in any Ranch Riding classes including Youth, Amateur and beginner classes..
13. In case of EI virus outbreak the Bundaberg and District Western Performance Club will not be responsible for any costs incurred or monies lost by an outbreak of EI to a competitor, spectator or volunteer.
14. Failure to abide by AQHA, HSAA BWPC rules & DPI&F Bio Security & BWPC Bio Security rules **MAY** result in instant disqualification from all shows and forfeiture of any monies paid or owing to the competitor.
15. ALL DOGS TO BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES (regardless of size)..
16. Refund Policy
 - a. If the show is cancelled - full refund/credit will be given excluding admin fees
 - b. If the show is postponed you must advise the club within 7 days of receiving notice to receive a full refund/credit excluding admin fees
17. REFUNDS: Definitely no refunds after closing date unless accompanied by a current Medical or Vet Certificate. Nomination refunds/credits excluding \$10 admin fees, will only be given when show secretary receives appropriate certificates i.e. vet certificate or doctor's certificate within 7 days of the event being held.
18. At all AQHA approved shows, on each day of the show, 1 hour prior to the commencement of the show and 1 hour after the cessation of the show, there will be no training equipment allowed in the immediate marshalling area and the performance arena and dress regulations of Cap/Hat, long western style pants, safe enclosed footwear and a shirt with sleeves must be worn
19. No alcohol is allowed in, or can be consumed in the marshalling areas, working arenas or show pen/contest areas.
20. Exhibitors shall not approach the judge for any reason prior to completion of the judging, unless the exhibitor has finished exhibiting and the request must be made through the Ring Steward.
21. No exhibitor will request information from the Judge, or the decisions made by that Judge, concerning any exhibit at a show, on the day of the show or within the immediate 7 days following the show.
22. Competitor's/participants at any event run by Bundaberg and District Western Performance Club Inc have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses and at all times to treat their horses humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion. Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity in all dealings with the Affiliate and other competitors. To uphold the rules and regulations of the Bundaberg WPC Inc at all times. Competitors/participants are to demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times, showing respect for your fellow competitors and officials, following the rules.
23. All youth competing or taking part in an approved event, must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event as a contestant or participant and in the case of a contest, the parent/guardian must also sign the entry form. All youth competing or taking part in an approved event, must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the youth is in attendance at that event.
24. Spectators or exhibitors must not approach the judge during the show. If there is a problem/enquiry this should be directed to the Show Secretary, President or Vice-President.
