The health, wellbeing and safety of all those who attend the 2021 Gresford Show is important to GDAS including competitors, staff, volunteers, visitors and members of the Gresford community. With this in mind, we ask that you follow all required practices to help minimise any possibility of COVID transmission. Please follow directives from COVID Marshalls.

- If feeling unwell please stay home, self-isolate and seek medical advice for testing.
- Practice Social Distancing at all times - 1.5 m apart.
- QR Code checkin is required of all competitors and visitors.
- Cough or sneeze into your elbow.
- Wash hands or use available sanitiser thoroughly & often - before and after eating, after using the toilet.
- People from, or who recently visited NSW Health identified Red Zones or Hot spots will not be allowed entry.
- Do not congregate in groups in stalls, competition areas or any other place on the grounds.
- Adhere to number limits in pavilions and other buildings.
- Use a face mask if you wish. (Not Mandatory)

- **ALL EVENTS MAY BE SUBJECT TO CHANGE PENDING NSW GOVERNMENT RESTRICTIONS AT TIME OF SHOW.**
- HORSE CLASSES AND CAMPDRAFT ENTRIES ARE TO BE MADE BY PRE PAID ENTRY ON '**NOMINATE**' WEBSITE. Closing date 8th March, 2021 for horse classes.
- CAMPDRAFT entries OPEN at 8am MONDAY 22ND February
- To reduce congestion at the entry to the grounds it is recommended that gate entry be pre purchased online for all attendees to the Show -competitors, family and friends, via NOMINATE website.
- Stud Cattle, Jnr Cattle Judging and Commercial Cattle Sections will take place as usual.
- The Pet Parade will go ahead on Saturday morning.
- The Poultry section will take place on Saturday as an exhibition display only – no judging or prizes
- The Grand Parade and Main Ring entertainment on Saturday will include invitational Six Bar Showjumping, Pony Club Troop Drill, invitational steer and mini bull rides, Ag bike demonstration,
- Post Splitting this year will be an invitation only demonstration in the Main Ring.
- Kids Disco on Saturday evening will be followed by the Fantastic Fireworks display.
- The PAVILIONS will be closed during the 2021 Gresford Show due to the COVID requirements and restrictions.

These sections will NOT be running for 2021:

Farm Produce, Vegetables & Fruit, Jams, Jellies, Pickles, etc; Cooking, Cut Flowers, Pot Plants & Flower Arranging, Fancywork, Art, Craft & Photography, Children's work and Cavvys & Bunnies.
