Mareeba All Breeds Horse Show Topsy Ring and Pony Club Ring Topsy Ring is open to non-registered and registered horses/ponies. This is a Beginners Ring for those who do not generally show. Approved riding boots and helmets must be worn at all times when in the ring. (Plaiting and Jackets are optional for this ring). No Spurs or whips will be allowed in this ring. For those assisting the assisted riders – you need to guide the child but you cannot pull the horse – the child needs to show to the best of their ability that they are getting the horse to do the event.

4001 Assisted Classes – Horse/Pony to be lead in a circle around the judges for judge to make their choice. When the judges has made their final decision, you will be instructed to stop. (If assisted, the child is to be leading the horse with the person assisting only holding the end of the lead rope. The person assisting the child is not to lead/drag the horse/pony.)

4003 Ridden Classes

All Riders will be asked to ride in a circle around the judge at a walk, trot and change direction when instructed by the judge at random times for all classes. Unassisted riders will be asked to canter within the circle – if a child cannot canter they should move into the circle and keep trotting within the circle to enable riders to canter as requested by the judge on the outside

(This is judged on the child's ability and the handler of the assisted classes is not to pull the horse – the child is to direct the horse/pony – the handler is only there on the lead line to keep control of the horse and must be not direct the horse.)





Class 4005 DOUBLE SET OF BARRELLS – WALK AROUND FULLY ONCE THEN TROT AROUND FULLY.





Class 7 – Barrels as per normal barrels


Class 4008 BARBED WIRE

See diagram below for course. Rider must finish in the marked area




Class 4009 Sporting Figure of eight

Rider must start within the course. First turn must be left hand around barrel A, then back through the starting sticks to turn right around barrel B, then back through the starting pegs. Rider must be able to stop at the start/finish line.




Class 4010 Double Trouble

Competitors must start on the left-hand side of the first stick, and bend alternatively right then left through the sticks. Then turn at the furthest stick to the right. Repeat for double figure of eight. Rider must stop within the marked area



Class 4011 Treble Clef


Start in middle. Circle around start barrel/stick. 2nd circle around bottom barrel/stick then up to and around top barrel/stick and through start barrel/stick. Two right turns one left turn. Must be able to stop in the marked area.



Class 4012

Egg Timer


Competitor rides over first jump and bends between the first two sticks, jumps second jump, turns left around drum, jumps second jump again, bends between sticks and jumps first jump again Rider must be able to stop within the marked area



Class 4013

Cotton Knot

Ride up through lane to top and turn left around stick down to middle break. Cross over to other side and go to bottom and loop to other side and back up the middle. Cross again and continue up to top, left hand turn around peg and back down the lane to start/finish line. Rider must finish in the marked area.



Boxes can be poles with a rail for guide
