All Pony Club entries must be approved by your club District Commissioner prior to entry. DCs will need to be notified of each rider's entries prior to entering through Nominate.

**NOMINATED HELPER** – For each rider a nominated helper will need to be listed on the entry form with name and phone number. The morning of the event the rider and nominated helper are to report to our committee when they collect their back number. Please note NO HELPER, NO RIDE.

**MULTIPLE HORSES** - A rider with more than one horse in the same class must abide by the draw. No classes will be held up to accommodate riders with two horses. No refunds will be given for riders who have not been able to participate in each phase.

QUALIFICATIONS - Riders must be bona fide members of the club which they represent in all inter-

WATER - Riders are required to bring their own water for horses

**LIABILITY** - Neither Tasmanian Pony & Riding Club Inc., the organising committee, nor the PCT accepts liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, ground, spectators, or any other person or property whatsoever.

**FIRST AID / VETERINARY** – A first aid officer will be onsite for dressage with full medical onsite for cross country and show jumping. A veterinarian will be onsite for show jumping and cross country.

**RESERVATION OF RIGHT** - The organisers reserve the right to cancel any class or event; divide any class; alter the advertised starting times; and refuse any entry with or without stating the reason.

**DRAW and RESULTS** – Entries will be forwarded to DC's and NTEC. Draw will be emailed via nominate. Results will be provide to NTEC and PCAT.

**RULES -** This event is run under PCAT Rules for Pony Club Eventing (EA plus PCAT Addendum) for Pony Club riders and the EA Eventing rules for EA riders. Refer to the link to the Handbook and look up PCT Handbook and Rules. Medical Armbands worn on the upper left arm are compulsory and the information must be up to date. They will be examined when back numbers are collected, and by the XC gear checkers.
