 Nominations for the CSI1\*-W will be accepted until Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> November but please provide expressions of interest by Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> October 2019. Definite entries are required by Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> November 2019.

- 2. Australian International 3 Day Event will conduct the 2019 Adelaide World Cup Qualifier Jumping Program under the auspices of Equestrian Australia (EA) in strict accordance with the FEI Jumping Rules, the EA National Show Jumping Rules (effective 1st July 2019, as amended) and the Australian World Cup Rules
- **3.** The following applies.

- (a) **RIDERS** must be financial members of EA and registered with the Federation Equestre International (FEI) where applicable.
- (b) HORSES must be registered with EA, have a current Jumping License and be owned by a financial member of EA. ALL COMPETITORS MUST HAVE A PHYSICAL COPY OF THEIR COMPETITION LICENSE. PRIZE MONEY WILL BE FORFEITED IF THE LICENSE IS NOT PRODUCED.
- (c) **WORLD CUP HORSES** must be registered with the FEI hold a current FEI passport.
- **4.** Entries **MUST** have **all horse**, **rider and owner** details including EA and FEI registration and membership numbers. All competitors must submit and pay for their entries via **NOMINATE**.
- **5. Swabbing:** Random swabbing will take place. A swabbing fee of \$25.00 per WC horse must be paid with entries. Please make yourself aware of prohibited substances and the relevant withdrawal period. Check the ingredients of all products you are using including herbal products with your vet. Security and access to the horse is the sole responsibility of the owner/rider.
- 6. All World Cup horse are required to stay on site in a stable in accordance with the FEI rules. Mini Prix horses may be brought on site daily however are subject to a veterinary inspection on their first arrival.
- 7. The Organizing Committee reserves the right at its absolute discretion to alter or amend any part of the program.
- **8.** Ten places in the Mini Prix class will be reserved for local competitors.
- **9.** The Organizing Committee reserves the right to ballot horses if necessary.
- **10.** Protests are to be submitted in writing to the show committee within 30 minutes of the incident or the announcement of placings and with a fee of \$50.00, to be refunded if protest is upheld.
- 11. Nominations for the World Cup Qualifier will be taken up to 14 days prior to the competition. No Late Entries will be accepted.
- **12.** Substitution of a nominated horse may take place only within the nominated Classes and must be notified to the Secretary at least one hous prior to the commencement of the class. Substitute World Cup horses must have passed the horse inspection
- **13.** Scratching: If notified prior to the commencement of the competition, 75% of entry fee will be refunded **only** if Veterinary Certificate or Doctors Certificate is produced within 3 days of the competition. No refund if after the commencement of the competition. There will be no refund on reserved stables unless a substitute can be found.
- **14.** No power cords are permitted to cross the roadways.
- **15. Prize money** will be paid directly into the competitor's nominated bank account within 10 working days of the event. **If incorrect bank details are supplied prize money will be forfeited.**

#### **VENUE TICKETS:** Access to Venue and Stable Area.

- World cup riders will be supplied with 1 x Athlete ticket, I x Groom ticket and 2 x Owners tickets
- Mini Prix riders staying on site will be provided with 1 x Athlete ticket to access the venue and stables for the duration of the event.
- Mini Prix riders arriving daily will be given access to the stable area and venue during the Mini Prix competition times only. The venue is free to the public after 4pm & during these competitions, so owners and/or family are welcome to attend.
- Grooms passes to access the venue for the event may be purchased for Mini Prix rider's grooms. Please contact Tessa Fairweather for details P: 0412 848 589.

**CAMPING**: Facilities are available for camping on the grounds: Please note that each vehicle brought to the grounds is required to have a pass.

- Powered sites \$320 for the duration of the event (Tuesday to Sunday) or \$220 (Thursday to Sunday) Includes 1 vehicle pass
- Preference will be given to World Cup riders and local South Australian Mini Prix riders are encouraged to come on a daily basis. Day parking available. Location to be advised.
