Event Classification	Closed Restricted & Official Competitive Conducted in accordance with the EA National Dressage Rules.
Judges	Danila Lochrin (NT) D Level and Jodi Triggs (NT) D Level
Eligibility to Enter	You must be a current financial member of Darwin Dressage Club (any category). Day membership is offered for this event, however please note: <u>day members will not be eligible for champion.</u>
Competition Conditions	No test may be called.
Special Awards	<p>Each level champion competition will receive the following:</p> <p>Competition placings 1st to 3rd place prize and a ribbon</p> <p>Competition 4th place a ribbon</p> <p>Champion Sash and \$20 cash prize money</p> <p>Reserve Champion Sash and \$15 cash prize money</p> <p>3rd Place sash and \$10 cash prize money</p> <p>Each level non champion competition will receive the following:</p> <p><u>Preparatory Only</u></p> <p>Competition placings 1st to 3rd place prize and a ribbon</p> <p>Competition 4th place a ribbon</p> <p><u>All other competition levels</u></p> <p>Competition placings 1st to 4th place a ribbon</p>
Presentation of Awards	The presentation of the awards will take place at the completion of the event on Sunday 23 August. Presentations will be unmounted; however, it is mandatory riders attend in <u>full riding attire</u> including jacket (if you wore one) and helmet.
Eligibility for Champion	<p>Placings will be determined by the highest aggregate percentages. In the event of a tie of placings, a count back will be done on the collective marks.</p> <p>For riders to be eligible to be awarded either a Champion or Reserve Champion placing, they must achieve a combined minimum test percentage of 55% in each championship test, per level. Only the final combined test percentage per level of competition (i.e. championship test) will be considered. Individual judge tests percentages will not.</p>
Fees	\$20 per test

Important Information	<p>All competitors must wear a bridle number either on both sides of their saddle cloth or bridle. If you don't have a bridle number and your horse is not currently EA registered, please contact Darwin Dressage Club to be issued one.</p> <p>Please note the start time, morning tea/lunch breaks and competition start times will be adhered to but riders should be ready to ride earlier than what the draw states (due to scratching). However, this will be no earlier than 15 minutes before your allocated time on the draw, and no earlier than when the competition is scheduled on the draw to commence.</p>
