Champions of Champion will be awarded to the combination per level (Prep – Big Tour) with the highest average percentage across all age classes. **Small Tour** is combined results PSG & Intermediate I, **Medium Tour** is combined results Intermediate A & B, **Big Tour** is combined results from Intermediate II & GP

Southport Pony and Hack Club have beautiful safe stables and undercover yards.

It is highly recommended horses be secured in a stable or stall when on the grounds as the majority of the parking is on bitumen.

- The responsibility of the sawdust is on each individual competitor and can be purchased at nomination. The sawdust at the grounds belongs to the agistees and is not available, there is a base layer of sawdust in all boxes and undercover yards.
- There is a \$15 fee/horse/stall or stable and must be cleaned upon departure.
- An additional Cleaning fee of \$15/stable if you wish for it to be cleaned for you.

Camping is available and can be booked at time of nomination.

HELPERS CONDITION: ALL riders to supply name of helper.

All riders must supply one helper for the day with a nominated job. All efforts will be made to ensure that helping times and ride times do not clash (when another person other than the rider is nominated) however this cannot always be guaranteed.

A compulsory \$40.00 fee will be payable should a rider not supply a helper on the day, or a helper fails to show up for their allocated job. Riders and helpers that fail to show up for their job will be eliminated automatically from their competitions unless the \$40.00 fee is paid.

1. This competition will be run under EA rules.
2. All entrants must be Equestrian Australia members, participant registered at a minimum or be current financial members of PCQ or PCA.
3. The draw will be posted on the Equestrian Gold Coast Club facebook page as soon as it is available.
4. A maximum of three tests per horse ridden over two consecutive levels. (FEI only two tests)
5. This event will be run as a timed draw. Each competitor must report to Gear Check at least 10 minutes prior to their class start time.
6. **Prior to presenting at Gear Check all competitors should take their completed Health Declaration form to Gear Check.**
7. Equestrian Gold Coast Club reserves the right to alter or cancel any section of this event/competition program or to cancel event/competition.
8. Refer to the Equestrian Gold Coast Club Facebook page for all event updates and notices. Should weather result in the cancellation of the event it will be posted at least two hours prior to the first class start time. In the event of cancellation, the admin fee will be withheld to help offset admin costs.
9. Scratchings received after the close of entries will need to present a vet certificate or medical certificate within 24 hours of the conclusion of the event to obtain a refund. The admin fee will be withheld on all scratchings. The competitor fee will not be refunded.
10. 10. This event will be run in accordance with a current COVID Safe Plan, EVERY person entering the grounds must log their attendance by checking in at the gate, all riders need the QLD Checkin app on their phones to assist with this process. Please adhere to social distancing rules & all current COVID guidelines, if you are unwell or have recently visited a COVID hotspot please DO NOT attend this event.
11. **Absolutely NO dogs are permitted on the Pony Club premises at any time.**
12. Lungeing is only to be done in the round yard.
13. Horses that are not on the competition draw are not permitted in the main ring on competition day.

Please note all Stallions must display EA Green Stallion Discs.

14. It is the riders' responsibility to know the EA Dressage rules and abide by those rules at all times. All Riders/grooms must follow the directions of the Ground Steward or Organising Committee at all times, including the instance of quarantine.
15. Abuse of horse, judge, other riders or committee members will not be tolerated. Abusive language will not be tolerated. Directions from the committee, ground steward or judge must be followed at all times. You will be eliminated and/or asked to leave the ground. You may also be yellow carded.
16. All children on Club Grounds must be under immediate adult supervision at ALL times.
17. The Southport Grounds is a public thoroughfare. It is recommend keeping gear and valuables secure in vehicles. Grounds are not fully enclosed.
18. **Gate in Twohill lane to be closed at all times.**
19. Note whilst toilet facilities are provided on the grounds, they are public toilets available for use by the Club and the general public.
20. All rubbish must be placed in the wheelie bins provided.
21. Power leads must not cross over roadways or pathways and must not be on the ground. If unsafe power leads are found they will be removed.
22. Consumption of alcohol or smoking is not permitted on the grounds.
23. Coffee van and full canteen will be available throughout competition.
