GENERAL INFORMATION

All classes will be run under PCASA rules.
Rules are available on the PCASA website: www.ponyclub.asn.au

- Pony club classes are open to members of PCASA affiliated pony clubs. PC combinations must have 4 qualifications to be able to compete (see PCASA rules).
- Open classes are open to EA and PCASA State Adult members. An additional \$15 PCASA Levy per rider applies.
- ODE competitors are asked to nominate a helper to assist with cross country jump judging. All jump judges are expected to attend a briefing at approx. 8am Sunday morning.
- PC riders and PCASA State Adults must present a current PCASA card.
- EA riders must show proof of current EA membership, their jumping license (Open 95 and 105cm only) and sign a waiver.
- PCASA rules for conduct of One Day Events will apply to all classes.
- Approved helmets (with PCASA tag), gear and riding boots must be worn by all riders.
- A medical armband and A4 size body number holder must be worn for cross country. Riders are to provide their own.
- Gear check compulsory for ALL riders prior to commencing each phase of the competition.
- Entries may be limited and will be accepted on a first come basis.
- COVID safe rules and restrictions will be strictly adhered to. Please do not attend if you are feeling unwell or have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive to or suspected of having COVID-19, in the last 14 days prior to the event.
- All people attending the event must check in with the QR code.
- No EFTPOS facilities available.

PROVISIONAL TIMETABLE

DRESSAGE: Commences 8.00am Saturday
SHOWJUMPING: Commences 9.30am Saturday
CROSS COUNTRY: Commences 9.00am Sunday

CROSS COUNTRY JUMP JUDGE BRIEFING: 8.00am Sunday

DRESSAGE TESTS - Pony club dressage tests are available on www.ponyclub.asn.au. EA eventing dressage tests can be found on www.equestrian.org.au.

CROSS COUNTRY - The cross-country course will be open for inspection from approx. 3pm on the Saturday. Maps of the course will be available on the CrossCountry App and from the Secretary's office. Check the course maps on display at the Secretary's office for any late course alterations.

WATER - Competitors must bring water for their horses, both for drinking and washing.

DOGS - Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. No dogs allowed on XC grounds on Sunday.

CATERING - Catering is available on both days including breakfast.

CAMPING - Camping is available on the grounds from Friday midday. Fee is \$25 per site for the weekend and can be booked with entry on Nominate. All campers will be notified by email prior to event where their allocated camp site is.

YARDS - A limited number of day and night yards are available at \$20.00 for the weekend and can be booked with entry on Nominate. First in, first served basis. Note that yards are a significant distance from camping area. Campers may make their own yard in the area provided.

REFUNDS - No refunds after closing date without a vet or doctor's certificate. Requests for Refund must be submitted within 7 days of the event and will incur a \$20 administration fee.

PROTESTS - Protests must be in accordance with PCASA rules for the conduct of One Day Events.

VENUE - Mountain Pony Club grounds, Williams Road, Mount Barker Springs
Directions: Exit the freeway at Mt Barker and travel toward Mt Barker, turn left at second roundabout.
Well past the Golf Club turn right at roundabout into Springs Road and follow the signs to the grounds on Williams Road, Mt Barker Springs. If taking the Bald Hills freeway exit, follow road/exit roundabout towards Mt Barker, at the top of the hill turn left into Springs Road, then left again into Williams Road.
