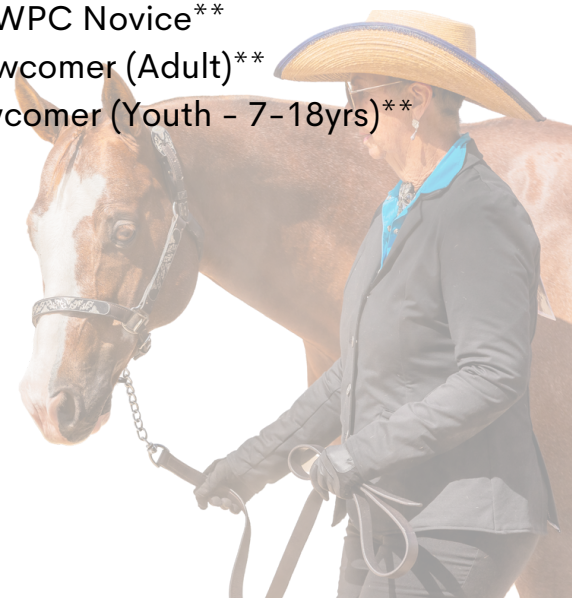

GENERAL SHOW RULES & ENTRY CONDITIONS

NORTH QLD CHAMPIONSHIP "A" SHOW 2026

- Australian Quarter Horse Association (AQHA) rules apply to this event except where TCWPC rules supersede (i.e., TCWPC classes).
- Every rider **MUST** be a member of TCWPC to compete or ride at an event. Temporary or day membership is available. All members (full or temporary) are bound by the TCWPC Code of Conduct.
- Submission of an entry form binds the Owner / Competitor of the agreement of the conditions of entry and Competition. Parent or Guardian must submit youth entries.
- The TCWPC Committee, Show Staff or volunteers will not be held responsible for any accident, sickness to any horse, owner, rider, handler or competitor, spectator or property. Horses and any person in attendance at the show, do so at their own risk.
- Feature Event Rule – **CLASS 34 TRIANDIBO INTOXICATING MEMORIAL HUNTER UNDER SADDLE FEATURE**. Entry Fee – \$25. **Tack, attire and equipment – as per AQHA Rule 82**. English Saddle (i.e. jump, dressage) & appropriate, AQHA / HSAA legal bit (i.e. English Snaffle, Kimberwick, Pelham and/or full bridle). Rider attire must include an Approved Safety Helmet, breeches /jodhpurs, hunt coat, boots – either high English boots or elastic sided boots, collared shirt, tie/choker or dickey) – gloves, spurs and crops are optional.
- Feature Event Rule – **CLASS 42 WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP JACKPOT FEATURE EVENT**. Entry Fee – \$25. Walk / Jog Class ONLY. **Tack, attire and equipment – as per TCWPC Club Division Rules (TCWPC Open, TCWPC Novice, Walk/Jog)**. Any western, stock/fender or English Saddle (i.e. jump, dressage) & appropriate, AQHA / HSAA legal bit (i.e. Snaffle or Curb). Rider attire (minimum) is long pants (jeans are fine), long sleeve shirt, hat or helmet and leather boots. Youth riders (under 18) must wear an approved safety helmet.
- All Youth competing or taking part in an approved event, must have written permission from their parent / guardian to be at that event as a contestant or participant (agreed to as part of your nomination forms). All youth competing or taking part in an approved event, must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the youth attend that event.
- Refund Policy – While the nomination period is open, competitors can process a refund minus any administration fees via Nominate. Once the nomination period is closed and up to 24hrs prior to the event, the Committee may consider a refund or future credit where a medical or vet certificate is provided, minus any applicable administration fees (i.e., administrative, prize or ground hire fee. **If scratching's occur 24hrs prior to the event, or on the day of the event, no refunds will be provided.**
- The show manager / secretary has the right to remove any person or persons from the ground, considered to be in breach of these rules and regulations or for any conduct deemed inappropriate by the organising bodies.
- No alcohol is allowed in, or can be consumed in the marshalling areas, working arenas or show pen/contest areas.
- Any guest, official, volunteer within the event main arena or marshaling areas **must** meet the dress requirements of cap/hat, long western style pants, safe enclosed footwear and a shirt with sleeves to be present in the area. This includes parents / guardians of youth exhibitors.

SHOW RULES AND ENTRY CONDITIONS

NORTH QLD CHAMPIONSHIP "A" SHOW 2026

- At all HSAA / AQHA shows, on each day of the show, 1 hour prior to the commencement of the show and 1 hour after the cessation of the show, there will be no training equipment allowed in the immediate marshalling area and the performance area.
- Exhibitors shall NOT approach the judge for any reason prior to completion of judging, unless the exhibitor has finished exhibiting and the request must be made through the ring steward or show secretary. No exhibitor will request information from the judge, or the decisions made by that judge concerning any exhibit at a show, on the day of the show or within the immediate 7 days following the show.
- Competitor's / participants at any event run by TCWPC have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses and at all times are to treat their horses humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion. TCWPC does not tolerate wilful abuse to horses. This includes obvious neglect, over training or improper training aids, and punishment. The committee (including appointed horse welfare officer) reserves the right to discuss any health and wellbeing concerns with the horse/s owner. All horses are in the care of the owners and handlers while attending the clinics and shows.
- The decisions of the judge are final.
- All riders under 18 must wear a helmet.
- Competitors / participants are to demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times, showing respect for your fellow competitors and officials, following the rules and to treat people the way you yourself wish to be treated.
- All competitors are required to wear a back number. – Back numbers will be provided to you by the club along with any competitor information. – Back numbers must be visible at all times i.e. – worn on your back (for led / halter events) or on both sides of the saddle blanket for ridden events. Please ensure back numbers are securely in place and do not move. – Each horse / rider combination must use a separate back number. – Failure to correctly display your back number will result in disqualification.
- Stallions will be welcomed as per event announcement. All stallions must be adequately secured (panel/tape) and haltered with an appropriate nose / lip chain. No youth are permitted to handle stallions.
- The show management committee reserves the right to alter the program as required.
- The TCWPC conditions of entry are to be abided by at all times.
- Entries will open as per the event announcement / flyer.
- Entries will close as per the event announcement. Giving enough days for the show committee to finalise paperwork, back numbers and run sheets. The show committee may accept late entries with a late entry fee, which will be advertised in the lead up to the closing date.
- Entries will be accepted only via the Nominate program or where otherwise specified.
- Our High Point and Club Awards will be presented at the completion of the event. Winners will also be announced on Facebook post the event. Please note that if you are unable to attend the presentation all **winners will need to arrange collection within 14 days of the event** or the prize will be forfeited and returned to the Club.

SHOW RULES AND ENTRY CONDITIONS

NORTH QLD CHAMPIONSHIP “A” SHOW 2026

- Patterns will be released when available from the Judge – and will be emailed to all nominated competitors directly.
- Where competitors bring their own yards, these are to be set up in the designated camping area unless otherwise specified. Pannels or electric tape are permitted – noting any damage caused by a loose horse will be the owner’s responsibility to pay for.
- All Rubbish and manure must be removed from camping areas and horse yards and moved to the specified area. Competitors who have used stables/yards available will be responsible for cleaning of manure / hay from yards. Where yards have been allocated, and are left in an undesirable state, those competitors will be charged a clean-up fee.
- Rubbish bins are located throughout the facility and all Rubbish is to be placed in these bins.
- While dogs are permitted to attend events, NO dogs are allowed to be near show pens, marshalling areas or warm up areas while horses are being ridden or worked – including the stable block/yards area. Dogs are to be leashed at ALL TIMES and to respect other people, kept quiet when left unattended. Dog waste is to be cleaned up and placed into rubbish bins. Failure to abide by these rules will result in you being requested to remove the dog from the grounds.
- Any maintenance or facilities issue is to be reported to a TCWPC Member.
- This is not a comprehensive list, but a general overview of the main rules & regulations. This is supplementary to HSAA, AQHA or TCWPC rules.

DIVISION OPTIONS & ENTRY RULES

NORTH QLD CHAMPIONSHIP "A" SHOW 2026

Open "AQHA" Classes

For all these classes, your horse will need to be a registered breed (AQHA, Paint, TB, ASH) and you will need to adhere to the horse age & equipment / tack rules under HSAA & AQHA.

Senior Horse

Open to horses aged 6yrs and over as of August 1st annually. To be ridden in any legal style of curb bit and chain with one hand. AQHA rules/regulations apply to this and all other equipment to be used. All competitors must be in suitably attired in Western Wear and ride in a western saddle.

Junior Horse

Open to horses aged between 2yrs and 5yrs as of August 1st annually. To be ridden in a snaffle bit with two hands or a curb bit and chain with one hand. AQHA rules/regulations apply regarding the choice of this and all other equipment to be used. All competitors must be in suitably attired in Western Wear and ride in western saddle.

Amateur Owner

An Amateur is a member who does not receive money or remuneration for horse related activities, that is, he or she is not a 'professional horse-person'. There are exceptions such as Veterinarians, Stud Owners/Managers and Farriers etc. The horse or horses used by an amateur participant must be owned or leased and registered wholly or in part by the participant and their name must appear on the horse's registration certificate. The member must possess a current breed specific Amateur card or via HSAA.

Select Amateur

If a person has attained the age of fifty (50) years and provides proof of age, which must be in the form of a copy of a drivers licence or birth certificate, then their Amateur Permit will be endorsed as to allow them to compete in Select Amateur classes. **NOTE: The Select Amateur Class and the Amateur Owner Class will be combined at the show, but official points will be recorded per division.**

Youth (Open)

Open to competitors aged 7-18yrs. All Junior and Senior horses in this class must be ridden according to AQHA rules/regulations for the age of the horse and equipment to be used. All competitors must be in suitably attired in Western Wear and ride in western saddle.

TROPICAL COAST WESTERN PERFORMANCE CLUB ONLY DIVISIONS

For all these classes, your horse can either be a registered breed (AQHA, Paint, TB, ASH) or a non-registered breed.

TCWPC Open

Definition: This is a Club specific Open division for more experienced riders or horses or those riders stepping up from Novice but who are not ready to compete in Open AQHA Classes.

Dress code is long pants (jeans are fine), long sleeve shirt, hat or helmet and leather boots. Open to any breed (registered or non-registered) and may be ridden in any snaffle bit (two handed) approved under HSAA and/or AQHA Rules). Open to any breed (registered or non-registered) and may be ridden in any bit comfortable to the horse and rider provided it is approved under HSAA and/or AQHA Rules).

TCWPC Novice

Definition: This is a Club specific division for either experienced riders from other disciplines or novice horses who are transitioning from other disciplines or those riders/horses progressing up from Newcomer. You are not eligible for this division if you have previously won in an AQHA Open division event in a class. I.e. If you have won a Am Owner or Senior Horse/Junior Horse division in Hunter Under Saddle, you are not eligible to compete in TCWPC Novice for that event. If you are competing in Open AQHA Classes at the same show, you are not eligible for this class.

Horse/rider combinations who wish to cross enter TCWPC Open and TCWPC Novice can do so but must be aware that if a TCWPC Open class is won, they will be required to move to TCWPC Open classes for that event moving forward. I.e. if a Hunter Under Saddle TCWPC Open Class is won, the horse/rider combination will be unable to enter TCWPC Novice division for that class at future TCWPC Events.

Dress code is long pants (jeans are fine), long sleeve shirt, hat or helmet and leather boots. Open to any breed (registered or non-registered) and may be ridden in any snaffle bit (two handed) approved under HSAA and/or AQHA Rules). Open to any breed (registered or non-registered) and may be ridden in any bit comfortable to the horse and rider provided it is approved under HSAA and/or AQHA Rules).

Newcomer (Adult & Youth)

Definition: This is a Club specific class and is designed for those youth/adult riders who are either new to the sport or new to showing or new to western performance events. Dress code is long pants (jeans are fine), long sleeve shirt, hat or helmet and leather boots.

You may compete in any saddle, be it western, English, stock or fender. You will be required to Walk, Jog (Trot), and Lope (Canter). You may compete on any horse regardless of age or breed, and ride in any bit that is comfortable to the horse and rider combination and approved under HSAA or AQHA Rules. Riders may compete in Newcomer Events for one full performance year (or 3 shows).

Walk / Jog (Adult & Youth)

This is a Club specific class and is designed for those riders or horses who are not as confident at all three gaits. You will only be required to walk & jog/trot. Class split between Youth and Adult - note Youth riders (under 18) must wear a helmet. Dress code is long pants (jeans are fine), long sleeve shirt, hat or helmet and leather boots. You may compete in either a western or stock / fender. You may compete on any horse regardless of age or breed, ridden in any bit that is comfortable to the horse and rider combination (and approved under HSAA and/or AQHA Rules). Note there is no ruling as to how long a rider can complete in Walk / Jog but if competing in this class, you cannot compete in any other class that requires a lope with the same horse/rider combination.
