

RESERVATION OF RIGHT

The Organisers reserve the right:

1. To cancel any class or event

CAMPING:

REFUNDS/SCRATCHINGS:

Prior to closing date riders may make alterations or scratching via the Nominate website.

Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date of entries and no later than 8 hours before the start of the competition unless a valid medical or veterinary certificate is provided to the event organiser within 48hrs of the completion of the event. An administration fee of \$15 will be retained by the event.

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- **No dogs are permitted on the grounds. If you choose to bring along a dog, please do not be offended when we kindly ask you to leave.**
- The riding phase is to be completed in your Pony Club cross country uniform (rally shirt), open riders are also required to wear long sleeves, approved jodhpur colours, approved boots and helmet as per PCWA rules.
- Riders are required to wear a **number bib** for the Ridden phase, RIDER MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN NUMBER BIB, (PAPER FORM OR MAGNETIC). Numbers will be provided for the running phase. A body protector is optional for the ridden phase, medical armband not required.
- Every competitor must supply a helper over the age of 16 years- if a helper is not provided, the competitor will not be allowed to compete. Please note that helper duties might also be short times on Saturday and Sunday, pending entry numbers.
- Event will be run under PCWA Tetrathlon and Eventing Rules. Refer to the PCWA Website for more information.
- The organisers reserve the right to: cancel any class or event, divide any class, transfer competitors between sections of a class, and alter advertised times.
- **Competitors are only allowed to enter one horse, in one class, per rider.**
- Age for classes is determined as at 1st January 2026.
- Competitors must be at least 8 years old on the 1st January 2026 to compete in the Tetrathlon phases, 6 years old for Equathon.
- Minimum age of competing horse is 4 years old.
- Yards must be arranged prior to the event. Please email creeka845@gmail.com to secure a yard. Limited spots available.
- Leaderboard: This event is a part of the 2026 PCWA Tetrathlon Leaderboard. Pairs and OPEN classes are excluded from the Leaderboard.
