Before Arriving at the Event

- **Riders** – you will receive an email with your event number attached. You **MUST** print this out **BEFORE** leaving home. **Make sure that you print two sheets.**
- **Download the CrossCountry App.** Download your course the day before the event. There will be limited maps available.

Arriving at the Event:

- Electric fences are not permitted, as per competition rules.
- No portable yards to be erected, unless with the permission of the OC.

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- There will be a designated manure piles. Please remove manure from your yard when leaving the event.
- Please make sure all your rubbish is either taken home with you or placed in the skip bins provided around the grounds.
- This event is run under EA Eventing rules
- Helmet tagging will be available at the event. Listen for announcements for times.
- Dressage starts at 8am on Saturday, please be ready to ride at your draw time. Please check the draw for details. Available at www.nominate.com.au and www.warwickhorsetrials.com.au.
- We are using paperless dressage. There will be no paper sheets available. Results and test scores will be available on the Nominate Equestrian App.
- All classes will jump on Saturday after dressage in **Sustainable** Main arena.
- All jumping will be in draw order except for multiple rides.
- Please abide by the EA Codes of Conduct.
- We have a number of multiple rides – please be organised and on time for your ride times. All show jumping will be in draw order except for multiple rides.

- **ALL PHASES:**
DO make sure you have an number on your horse.
- **DRESSAGE:**
DO download your dressage test off the [nominate website](#).
DO – wear gloves
- DON'T – bring your whip to the arena
- DO learn your test – callers are not permitted.
- **SHOW JUMPING:**
DO jump the practice jump with red flag on right.
If you do get eliminated in the Show Jumping
DO ask the Technical Delegate if you can ride in the XC
- **Please listen and be respectful to all volunteers and officials.** Remember all these people are volunteers, without whom this event would not happen.

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Our volunteers and officials are very valuable assets - please treat them with respect

- **CROSS COUNTRY:**

- **Print two copies of your back number**

- DO check when you are buying a back protector that it will meet the new standards.

Cross country phase you need a back number holder, and a medical armband. A bridle number on your horse.

- Only warm up over jumps that are marked for your class. Coloured squares will tell you which is yours!

- **DON'T** forget to tie up your long hair. Your back number needs to be visible!!

- **GENERAL:**

Make sure you have ID for your horse on its halter – include your name & phone number.

- **DON'T** get so tense that you can't enjoy yourself!!! This is meant to be fun!!!
- **DO** ask questions – we want everyone to have fun!
- Colour Guide for Cross Country – please note that the 45-50 class will be numbered with Orange numbers, the 60 class will be numbered with purple number. Please refer to the colour guide.
