Pony club entries \$70 1st horse & \$60 for 2nd horse (includes ambulance levy per horse)

Approved Riding Helmets, Approved Riding Boots & Numbers must be worn by all competitors when mounted.
Body Protectors and Medical Armbands are COMPULSORY for ALL GRADES for the Cross Country Phase

All PC riders must notify their DC of their entry

EA entries \$90 1st horse & \$70 for 2nd horse (includes ambulance & TEA levy per rider) –
non-TEA members will pay an additional \$100 fee

This Event will be held under current Equestrian Australia/FEI Horse Trial Rules, and the National Eventing Rules January 2021 and all subsequent corrections and modifications as published by the FEI and EA with their provisions taking precedence. PLEASE NOTE Back Protectors and Medical Armbands will be compulsory for the x-country phase for all riders. EA tagged helmets are compulsory

DRESS As per Equestrian Australia rule no. 538.

EA riders – a copy of your entry will be sent to your club's president to check eligibility

MAXIMUM 2 HORSES PER RIDER

All manure and hay to be placed in wheelbarrows provided & all rubbish in rubbish bins provided.
Water will be available but riders encouraged to bring own supply.

STRICTLY NO DOGS ALLOWED

ALL personnel entering the grounds MUST check in to comply with COVID regulations
