- **NO LATE OR PAPER ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED**
- **A copy of a correctly completed Horse Health Declaration must be handed in on arrival to the competition, a wrist band will then be handed to the rider. NO WRIST BAND NO RIDE.**

- **All Biosecurity and current Government COVID procedures must be followed.**
- EA Rules Apply
- **No refunds after close of entries unless vet / medical certificate supplied.**
- In case of cancellation an administration fee of 20% may be retained by the organising committee of the club
- If less than 4 riders in any class prize money may be halved at the discretion of Committee.
- Entries may close early if nominations fill prior to closing date.
- Competitors need to be either an EA member or a CDA Member (Full or Day Membership), Current Membership will be checked prior to the draw being issued. Limited day membership is available- find the addition on nominate to add fee to nominations - Cost is \$20.00
- Facility fee, includes the use of a day yard.
- Each horse and rider combination may only compete in a total of 3 classes in two consecutive levels.
- Participant Prep A- **ONLY HORSE AND RIDER COMBINATIONS WHO HAVE NOT WON A PREP CLASS PREVIOUSLY ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THIS CLASS.**
