Competitors must be members of Equestrian Australia to compete in 105cm and above with current horse competition licenses.

Competitors may enter two classes each day as stipulated on the top page of class listings.

Competitors must be members of Jumping Tasmania through membership of 1 of the 4 Jumping Tasmania branches.

EA Members who are not Jumping Tasmania members may enter but will incur a \$10 levy per class.

Conditions of Entry

- Riders may only enter 2 classes each day.
- Organising committee reserves the right to limit entries or some or all of the classes offered.
- Class changes must be notified to the Judge prior to the commencement of competition for the day, any change requested after the start of competition the combination will compete HC.
- ALL manure and hay MUST be cleaned up from around floats and trucks and removed from the grounds.
- ALL rubbish MUST be removed from the property.
- Riders must comply with all EA policies and by-laws.
- Prizes and classes may change if required at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
- Competitors may be offered a refund on proof of vet or doctor certificate prior to competition date.
- Any protest must be made with-in 30 minutes of the end of the class the protest relates to and must be accompanied by a \$50 cash deposit (refunded if the protest is successful)

Competitors may be offered a refund on proof of vet or doctor certificate prior to the day of competition.

In the case of the organising committee cancelling the event, entries will be refunded minus the Nominate fees.

Article 238.2.1

Athletes with equality of Penalties for any place are placed in accordance with the time taken to complete the round. In the event of equality of Penalties and time for first place, there may be a jump-off over a shortened course over obstacles, which may be increased in height and/or spread in accordance with the provisions of the Schedule.

Article 274.2 (Super)Two-Phase Competition

2.1 This Competition comprises two phases run without interruption, each at an identical or different speed, the finishing line for the first phase being identical with the starting line for the second phase.

2.2 The first phase is a course of five to seven obstacles with or without combinations. The total number of obstacles in both phases is a minimum of 11 and maximum of 13 obstacles. The second phase may include one combination.2.3 Athletes completing the first phase may continue in the second phase.

Placings

According to the aggregate penalties in both phases (faults on obstacles and penalties for exceeding the time allowed in both phases) and, if necessary, according to the time of the 2nd phase.

Article 273 – Competition over Two Rounds

1. This Competition comprises, with the same speed, two courses, identical or different, either in track or in number of obstacles or in the dimensions of the obstacles. Each Athlete must participate with the same Horse. Athletes, who have been eliminated or who have retired during the first round, may not take part in the second round and may not be placed.

2.2. A limited number of Athletes (either a percentage or a set number of Athletes, in any case at least 25%) return for the second round in accordance with their placing in the first round (Penalties and time or Penalties only, according to the conditions of the Schedule); the exact percentage or number of Athletes to return for the second round is to be mentioned in the Schedule. 3.3.2 A competition run under table A conditions in which the first round is not against the clock. Athletes returning for the second round will ride against the close, riding in reverse order of penalties taken in the first round. In the case of equal penalties in first round, athletes to retain their draw order. No jump-off.
