### **Stable Manager On-Site**

Nick will be on-site daily from **6:30 AM to 6:00 PM**.

Arrivals must occur during these hours.

- Please ensure all Nominate payments are up to date.
- Early Entry: From 3:00 PM, Wednesday, 1st October, available for interstate arrivals.  
**No horse riding** permitted before 12:00 PM on Thursday without prior arrangements.
- Portable stables still available.

### **Thursday 2nd October**

- Horse arrival & riding: From 12:00 PM to 6:00 PM
- Arenas open: Arena 4 & 11
- Dressage arena familiarisation – Times TBA

### **Safety First**

- **Paramedics on-site:** 6:30 AM – 6:00 PM  
**No riding outside these hours**
- After a fall, report to a paramedic before riding again.
- If a horse falls, it must be cleared by the event veterinarian before competing or leaving.

### **AVAILABLE ON EQUIPE**



Equipe App for both Android and iPhone. You get an up-to-date start list with just a single click. Every time a result is submitted for a rider/horse, it will automatically get pushed to Equipe Online and push notification will be sent out to people with accounts following the rider or horse.

## **General Safety Reminders:**

- SIEC roads are public roads – obey speed limits.
- Use horse paths when riding or leading your horse, not vehicle roads.
- No spectator vehicles past second security hut.
- No powered scooters or bicycles/scooters.
- Disability vehicles allowed (restricted to pedestrian areas).
- Helmets must be tagged (excluding Show Horse).
- Follow all instructions from event staff and stewards.
- Only registered riders and horses may participate.
- No dogs in stables, warm-up, or competition areas.  
If your dog must attend, please keep it secured at your float or camping.

## **Day Stay – Stabling – Camping - Cabins**

### **Day Stay Parking**

- Available at P9  
Do not park in camping areas  
Gates open: 6:15 AM

### **Stabling Info**

- Unloading: Use unload area near stables; move vehicle after.
- 3 bales of shavings provided per stable.
- No external shavings allowed (including water-activated).
- Check stabling allocation and apply stable sticker with bridle number.
- Stables must be fully cleaned before departure for bond refund.
- If you need your stable cleaned, please Pre Book with Nick before leaving.
- Stable bond refunds may take up to 2 weeks.

### **Camping**

- Camp only in your allocated space
- All powered sites = One plug only

**Cabins** – Keys can be collected from the Stable Manager

## Lunging & Round Yards

- Lunging allowed only in designated round yards:
  - No lunging in P9
  - Arena 12 (Saturday only)
- Max 30 minutes per session
- Round Yards open: 6:00 AM – 6:30 PM
  - No use outside of these hours
  - Lunging elsewhere or outside hours = disqualification
  - Excessive lunging not tolerated

## Bridle Numbers

- Bridle numbers must be worn at all times when your horse is outside of its stable.
- On arrival, while grazing, or when tied to your float, the number must be clearly displayed on the halter.
- During warm-up or competition, the number must be attached to the bridle, saddle blanket, or breastplate.
- Failure to display a visible bridle number may result in a warning from officials.

## Swabbing

- If selected, your horse will go directly from the arena to the Swabbing Stables.
- If the rider is unable to take the horse, please ensure an authorised person is present.
- All horses must have an EA Registration number.
- **IDENTIFICATION CHECKS**
- Identification checks may be conducted by Stable Managers, Welfare Stewards, and Swab Stewards throughout the event.
- By entering the event, you agree that your horse may be **scanned (microchip)** and/or **swabbed** at any time.
- Please ensure your horse's **EA registration papers** are readily available upon request

## Dress & Saddlery

- Must comply with discipline-specific rules
- Jackets optional in hot weather – rider discretion

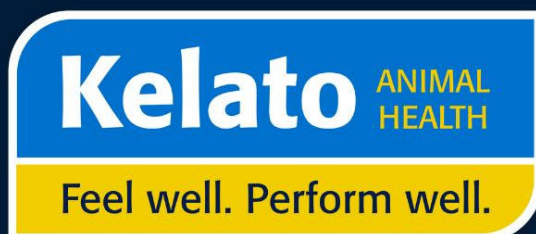

Arena Familiarisation – Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> October 3.30pm to 4.30pm – Walk and Trot only

<b>Arena Hacking 1 and 2</b>	<b>Warm up in Arena Hacking</b>

**Gear Check – Compulsory after your test – otherwise you will be eliminated from the class.**

- Warm-up: Arena 4 + small area in Arena 1 before your class
- New Star Led must be in a snaffle bridle
- Workouts have been emailed to competitors
- Class presentations will occur in-ring after each class.

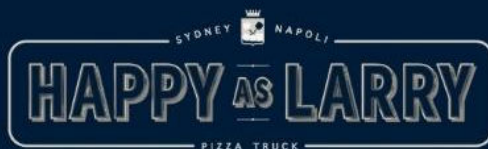
