## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All people entering the grounds, competitors and handlers do so voluntarily. Neither the organizing committee nor The Australian Stock Horse Society Limited accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to the horses, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
2. **Membership & Registration Numbers** must be supplied with entry
3. Horses must be registered with the Australian Stock Horse Society Ltd and membership papers must be produced on request, or you will be ineligible to compete. Youth under 18 yrs allowed to ride an unregistered horse.
4. All youth competitors must be members of the Australian Stock Horse Society. Adult riders may purchase a day membership.
5. Protests must be lodged on the day in writing with a \$50.00 fee, which will be refunded if the protest is upheld.
6. The committee has the right to delete, defer to alter the program of events on the day.
7. All colts & stallions must be handled and ridden by a person 18 years & over.
8. All colts & stallions when tied up must wear a collar and be double tied.
9. Handlers & competitors must be suitably attired according to the ASHS Handbook – no joggers permitted.
10. Horses must be bridled and saddled when being ridden on the grounds.
11. All competitors under 18 years must wear an Australian Stock Horse Approved equestrian helmet in all events including led, junior handler classes and when riding on the grounds at all times.
12. A **Novice** horse is a horse that has not won a novice or 1 open class at any show, open gymkhana or similar event, except wins in youth, consolation or restricted age classes. Any Horse that wins an Open Championship or Supreme regardless of age will no longer be a Novice.
13. **Classes will not be held for any competitor.**
14. The CCASH committee have the right to alter any of the prizes nominated on this program without notification.
15. **Encouragement Challenge** – the rider must not have placed in final placings in any Open challenge or won an Encouragement challenge.

#### MUSTERING AND CHECKING FENCES.

Not including obvious equipment such as saddle and bridle, competitors **must choose 6 items** from the below list. Competitors must explain to the judge why you chose those 6 items, and why you didn't choose any of the remaining items.

Fence pliers

Wire

Stock whip

Water container

Shoe nails

First aid kit

Flint

Matches

Toilet paper

Communication device

Food – human consumption

Water

Halter and lead rope

Hobbles

Baling twine

Sun protection



1. Present to Judge at A
2. Canter a semi circle over jump. Continue right lead canter to barrel
3. Stop at barrel. Pick up item.
4. Carrying item, trot around B, returning to barrel
5. Replace item on barrel. Rein back for 6 paces. Stand for 5 seconds.
6. Canter to gate. Stop. Open and shut gate.
7. Canter on left lead over jump.
8. Continue in a relaxed canter to C. Roll back. Canter to D. Roll back.
9. Canter to E. Stop. Walk to judge on a loose rein.
